

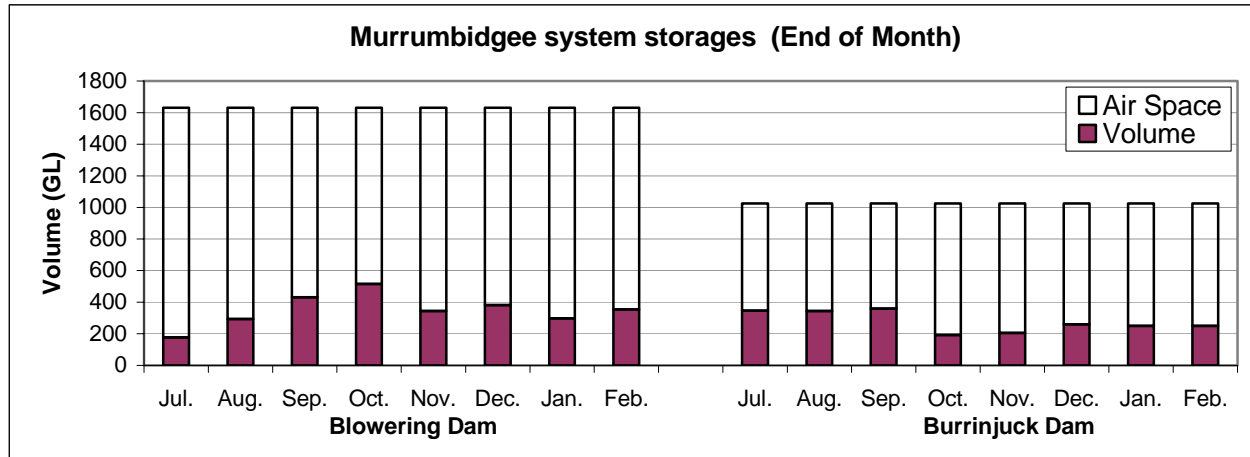

Current Murrumbidgee Valley Allocations

For normal allocations for 'minimum' or equal to worst inflow conditions the allocations are:

Domestic & Stock		100% of Entitlement
Water Utilities		100% of Entitlement
High Security Access Licences	0.95 ML/Unit Share	95% of Entitlement
General Security Access Licences	0.37 ML/Unit Share	37% of Entitlement
