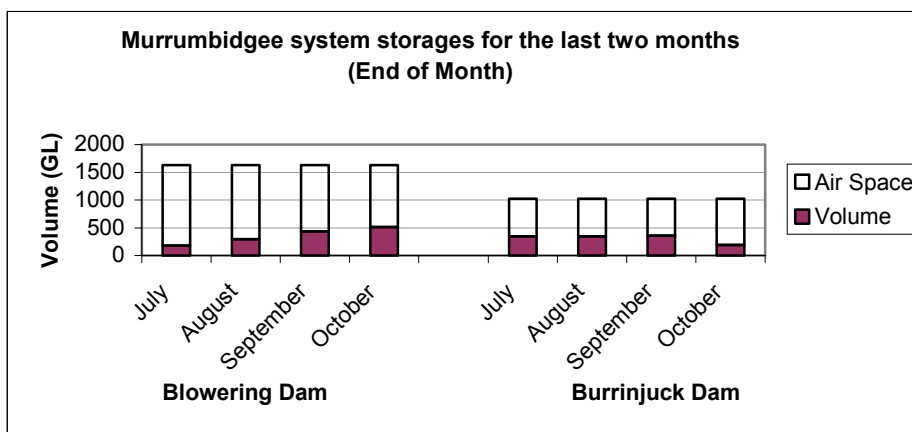

Possibilities of improvement

Assessment of the water available for allocation for the other inflow conditions has produced the following results:

9 chances in 10 (v. dry)	90%	n/a	30 %	31 %
3 chances in 4 (dry)	75%	n/a	36 %	37 %

Current Murrumbidgee Valley Allocations

For normal allocations for 'minimum' or equal to worst inflow conditions the allocations are:

Domestic & Stock		100% of Entitlement
Water Utilities		100% of Entitlement
High Security Access Licences	0.95 ML/Unit Share	95% of Entitlement
General Security Access Licences	0.26 ML/Unit Share	26% of Entitlement
