

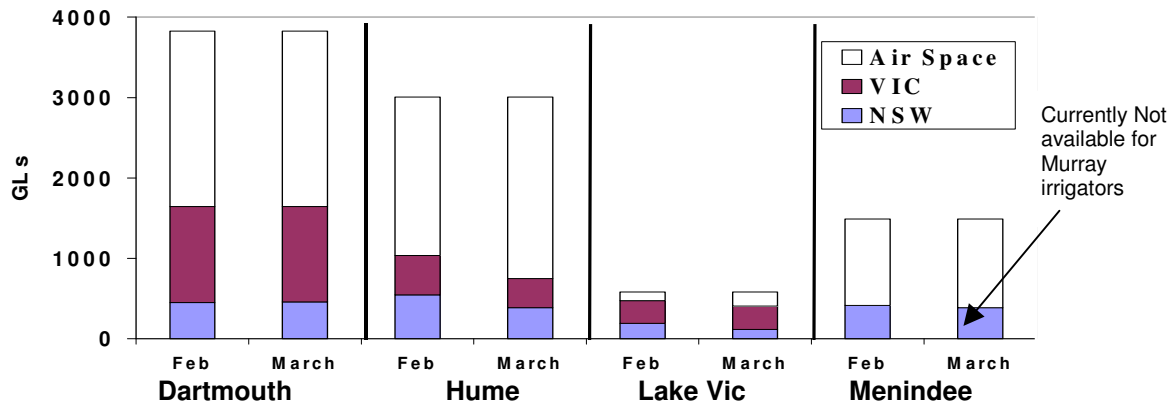

For normal allocations for 'minimum' or equal to worst inflow conditions the allocations are:

Domestic & Stock		100% of Entitlement
Water Utilities		100% of Entitlement
High Security Access Licences	0.97 ML/Unit Share	97% of Entitlement
General Security Access Licences	0.49 ML/Unit Share	49% of Entitlement

Supplementary Water.

Supplementary water (Off-allocation) remains opportunistic. When announced, licenced general security users may divert water consistent with rules announced in the Water Allocation Plan for 2004-05.
