

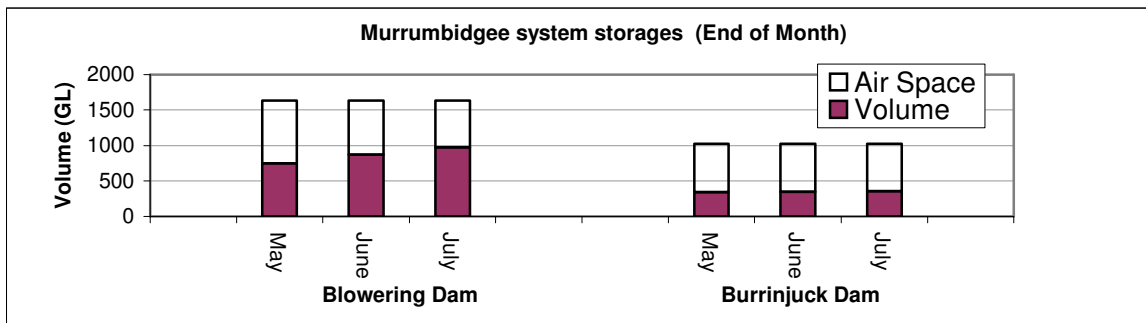

### Current Murrumbidgee Valley Allocations

For normal allocations for 'minimum' or equal to worst inflow conditions the allocations are:

Domestic & Stock		100% of Entitlement
Water Utilities		100% of Entitlement
High Security Access Licences	0.95 ML/Unit Share	95% of Entitlement
General Security Access Licences	0.18 ML/Unit Share	18% of Entitlement
Supplementary Water Access Licenses	1 ML/Unit Share	100% of Entitlement

### Supplementary water

Supplementary Water (Off-allocation) remains opportunistic. When announced licensed general security users may divert water consistent with rules announced in the Murrumbidgee Annual Allocation Plan for 2005-06.
