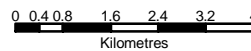

Name of Water Source:

Jilliby Jilliby Creek Water Source

Relevant Water Sharing Plan: Water Sharing Plan for the Jilliby Jilliby Creek Water Source gazetted on 7 February 2003 and as amended by order on 1 July 2004.

Description of Water Source:

The Jilliby Jilliby Creek Water Source is that area of land within the Central Coast Water Management Area as shown in Map 12, upstream of the junction of Jilliby Jilliby Creek with the Wyong River, adjacent to the common boundaries of the parishes of Wyong, Munmorah, Ourimbah (County of Northumberland); at a point on Jilliby Jilliby Creek adjacent to the southern-most point of Lot 41, DP 755271 (Parish of Wyong, County of Northumberland) on the western bank of Jilliby Jilliby Creek and the southern-most point of Lot 1, DP 124986 (Parish of Munmorah, County of Munmorah, County of Northumberland) on the eastern bank of Jilliby Jilliby Creek.

Definition of Waters Included:

The waters of the Jilliby Jilliby Creek Water Source include all water occurring on the land surface shown on Map 12, including but not limited to, Armstrongs Creek, Calmans Gully, Edwards Gully, Jilliby Jilliby Creek, Little Jilliby Creek, Lowers Gully and Myrtle Creek.

This definition also includes any lakes and wetlands in this water source.

The waters of this water source exclude all water contained within aquifers underlying this water source.
