## Terms and Conditions of nomination to be billed under the IPART Two-Part Unregulated Tariff \*

1. I/we have a meter<sup>†</sup> installed for the measurement of water
2. I/we certify that the meter measures the total of all water taken in accordance with the conditions of this licence.
3. I/we certify that the meter complies with the NSW Water Extraction Monitoring Standards, available at [http://www.dnr.nsw.gov.au/water/pdf/nsw\\_extraction\\_monitoring\\_standards-final.pdf](http://www.dnr.nsw.gov.au/water/pdf/nsw_extraction_monitoring_standards-final.pdf)
4. I/we certify that the meter has been installed in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications, and I/we agree to make these specifications available to the Department of Water and Energy (the Department) or its agent upon request.
5. I/we agree to supply, on request by the Department, a test certificate furnished either by the meter manufacturer or by some other suitably qualified person or authority.
6. I/we agree to maintain the meter in accordance with any instructions from the manufacturer and any directions from the Department.
7. I/we agree to supply meter readings to the Department (in a manner acceptable to the Department) on a three-monthly basis or as otherwise specified, in writing, by the Department.
8. I/we agree that if acceptable meter readings are not received by the Department, that billing will revert to the one-part volume of entitlement charge as specified by IPART.
9. I/we attach a map or sketch showing the location of the meter and approved work.
10. I/we agree that the Department officers are authorised to undertake inspections, tests and verification readings of the meter as and when required, and I/we agree to allow reasonable access by the Department to the meter and associated equipment.
11. I/we agree that for the purposes of water charges, this election will take effect in the immediate, subsequent billing year (starting 1 July), and no earlier than three months from the date of receipt of this Election, unless mutually agreed by the Department and myself/ourselves.

**Note:** References above to the Department also apply to agents or contractors engaged by the Department of Water and Energy to undertake activities in relation to water metering, water-use monitoring, or water billing.

\* The following IPART fees apply in the case of an irrigator who has a meter and who elects to be charged in accordance with clause 4.1 (b), the higher of:

- 1) An annual charge of \$60.00; and
- 2) The sum of a two part tariff consisting of:
  - i) An entitlement charge (being a charge expressed in dollars per megalitre of entitlement or in dollars per unit share) in table 6 of the relevant river valley and relevant year, multiplied by a licence holder's entitlement or unit share for that year and multiplied by the conversion factor in clause 8 of this Schedule; and
  - ii) A usage charge (being a charge expressed in dollars per megalitre of water actually extracted) in Table 6 for the relevant river valley and relevant water year, multiplied by a licence holder's usage for that year.

<sup>†</sup> **Meter** means:

- (a) An apparatus (approved by the Department) for the measurement of water extracted from unregulated rivers and installed (with the approval of the Department) on, or near the licence holder's off-take point or points; or
- (b) A methodology (approved by the Department) for the measurement of water extracted from unregulated rivers.
